2. RACE REGULATION

The competition complies with the technical and sporting regulations of the UCI (International Cycling Union), for the UCI Elite categories for men and women; the rest of the Master categories follow the Technical Regulations of the RFEC (Royal Spanish Cycling Federation) and the Cadet and Junior Categories follows the FCC (Canarian Cyclist Federation) Regulations.

2.1. GENERAL

MTB Categories

Participants registered in the MTB modality can register in any of the following categories. The ages are calculated in reference to the age of the participant on December 31 of the year of the competition:

- Male UCI Elite: Both must hold an approved UCI Elite license, strictly comply with all UCI regulations, compete for UCI points and prize money in the general classification and per stage.
- <u>Female UCI Elite</u>: Both must hold an approved UCI Elite license, strictly comply with all UCI regulations, compete for UCI points and prize money in the general classification and by stage.
- Master 30 (M / F). Those who hold an Elite category license will not be able to compete
 in this category. They will not get UCI prizes or prize money.

- Master 40. (M / F). Those who hold an Elite or Master 30 license will not be able to compete in this category. They will not get UCI prizes or prize money.
- Master 50 (M / F). Those who hold an Elite, Master 30 or Master 40 license will not be able to compete in this category. They will not get UCI prizes or prize money.
- Master 60 (M / F). Those who hold an Elite category license, Master 30/40/50 will not be able to compete in this category. They will not get UCI prizes or prize money.
- Junior (M / F). Participants born year 2006-2007. Participants in the Junior division can only compete in both Stage 1 and Stage 2.
- <u>Cadets (M / F).</u> Participants born year 2008-2009. Participants in the Cadets division
 can only compete in both Stage 1 (Saturday) and half of the course of Stage 2. They will
 receive a personal information at the race pack collection regarding the 2nd stage start
 time and meeting point at the start area.

E-Bike Categories

Participants registered in the E-Bike modality can register in any of the following categories. The ages are calculated in reference to the age of the participant on December 31 of the year of the competition:

- Master 30 (M / F). Those who hold an Elite category license will not be able to compete in this category. They will not get UCI prizes or prize money.
- Master 40. (M / F). Those who hold an Elite or Master 30 license will not be able to compete in this category. They will not get UCI prizes or prize money.
- Master 50 (M / F). Those who hold an Elite, Master 30 or Master 40 license will not be able to compete in this category. They will not get UCI prizes or prize money.
- Master 60 (M / F). Those who hold an Elite category license, Master 30/40/50 will not be able to compete in this category. They will not get UCI prizes or prize money.
- Junior (M / F). Participants born year 2006-2007. Participants in the Junior division can only compete in both Stage 1 and Stage 2.
- <u>Cadets (M / F).</u> Participants born year 2008-2009. Participants in the Cadets division
 can only compete in both Stage 1 (Saturday) and half of the course of Stage 2. They will
 receive a personal information at the race pack collection regarding the 2nd stage start
 time and meeting point at the start area.

The bicycle

Bicycles must be in accordance with the UCI regulations, both in terms of technical characteristics and safety. Participants are allowed to change their bicycles from stage to stage, but they cannot be completely replaced or changed during a stage. Tandem bicycles are not allowed.

E-BIKE: The E-bike coordinator will ensure that all e-bikers compete under the same technical conditions.

- Strictly serial models with assisted pedalling system.
- Battery with a maximum power of 800 W/h

- Power limiter that cuts off at 25km/h.
- Homologated by the CE, according to European Directive 2002/24/EC defined in Article 1, point h).
- The motor should only activate when pedalling and must stop acting when pedalling ceases (they cannot have a throttle).
- Weight less than 40 kg.
- The bicycle cannot have modifications or additions that alter its factory characteristics.

<u>The battery:</u> Competing with more than one battery is not allowed, and the battery will be checked at the beginning and at the end of the race. Failure to comply with this rule will result in the competitor's withdrawal from the race, the removal of their race number, and the inability to register for the next two editions.

Sport and environment

Mountain biking is a competitive sport or leisure activity that takes place in a natural environment, and the impact it can have on the environment is the responsibility for all participants and race Organisers. It is strictly forbidden to litter along the route. Participants must be respectful of the environment (do not pedal off the road/ tracks and do not take shortcuts that could damage the vegetation), be careful with the animals, etc.

There will be bins at the beginning and at the end of each feed technical zone. There won't be any along the rest of the course.

The participants' own nutrition will be marked. This way, the organization can identify the owner of any litter found along the course. The commissaires reserve the right to disqualify any participant who does not respect the environment, or the private properties encountered on the race course, and to expel him/her without possibility of continuing to participate in the competition.

Withdrawal from competition during the race

Any participant who withdraws must inform the organisation as soon as possible.

The organisation will determine intermediate points where the participants will be able to communicate the withdraw, as well as they will be informed of a mobile number where they can notify it. Failure to report a withdrawal will result in expulsion from the competition.

In case of accident or emergency, and considering the safety of the participants, the organisation reserves the right to force the withdrawal of a participant from the competition.

Claims

Claims must be formally addressed to the Referees and processed by them in accordance with the UCI regulations. Enrolling the 4 Stage Mountain Bike Race Lanzarote implies the acceptance and compliance with this regulation, the data protection act and the cancellation policy.

Event beyond control of the Race organiser

In case of unforeseen events beyond the control of the race Organiser, the Organisation could modify or cancel the event, and this will be communicated by the organisation the day prior the race during the briefing or on race day.

Any participant or team that have not crossed the finish line at that time may be evacuated by the organisation. If any participant continues the race, this will be under his/ her responsibility.

Cancellation due to climatological reasons

Due to climatological reasons or any other reason that prevents the race from being carried out in complete safety, the organisation may implement some changes in the race courses or reduce the distance, if necessary. The reduction of segments, the reduction of the circuit, cancellation of any stage or any other alteration in the sports event will not lead the organizer to any refund of the entry fee, either partially or in full. In case of any kind of disqualification or abandonment of the competition, the registration fee will not be reimbursed in whole or in part.

In the official Event website and social media channels we will report any last-minute information. It's the responsibility of the participants to be aware of them.

Race Organisation

- The organisation is not responsible for any failure or repair of the bicycle that may happen during the race.
- All the participants give their image rights to the organisation, for the use of any pictures or video where they appear.
- The organisation does not take care of the expenses or debts that a participant may incur during the event.
- Lost objects. The Race organisation is not responsible for lost/stolen property or for any lost or forgotten object along the route or during the course. On race day, all lost and found items will be brought to the North Reception, Club La Santa.

Other considerations

- Any participant can be submitted to an official anti-doping control in accordance with the UCI regulations.
- All participants must be respectful towards the other participants, referees, members
 of the organisation, media and public. Assaults, disrespect or any other
 unsportsmanlike conduct may be sanctioned with immediate expulsion from the
 competition.
- Completing the race with other means than the individual physical effort of the participant and their own bicycle supposes the disqualification of the participant.

The referees can disqualify any participant that does not respect these considerations expelling them from the race without the possibility of continuing in it.

2.2. COURSE REGULATION

The competition is composed of two or four stages.

Race Start

- The competition is held in accordance with the general UCI regulations, the specific regulations of the UCI for Mountain Bike. The start of all the stages, except for chrono climb (stage 3), are in "peloton" (bunch).
- The start list order will be according to the UCI ranking on the 22/01/2024. The start lists will be published in the official race website, Club La Santa Races App and social media prior to each race start.
- The starting grid opens twenty (20) minutes before the start time. Five (5) minutes before the start time, no participant is allowed to enter the grid, and must be placed in the back of the corresponding starting group.
- No participant may take the start once the official start has been given, unless a referee consent this. Riders who start after that time will be considered DNS (Did Not Start).
- Neutralised starts: For security reasons, the start can be neutralized. In this case, the
 Race Director leads the participants in an official vehicle. When the Race Director starts
 the race, the participants must start competing. When the official vehicle of the
 competition reaches the end of the neutralized section, it moves aside and indicates
 the end of the neutralized section. During the neutralization it is forbidden to overtake
 the official race vehicle of the Race Director.
- Neutralised arrivals: For safety reasons, the finish line can be placed a bit before, before reaching a stretch of asphalt.

Traffic

- The route is open to traffic, but properly controlled.
- The riders must follow the directions of the traffic authority and circulate with caution.
 On Spanish public roads, cyclists must keep the right. On tracks, it is advisable to ride on the right side.
- The paths included in the race courses are exclusively for the race days of the competition.

Check points

During the race two types of controls are established: check point (CP) and check of intersection (CI). In the check point, a referee records the participant's number and time. It will be cause for disqualification:

- Omitting a check point.
- Not following the indications of an intersection control.
- Leaving the course marked by the organisation.

Cut-offs

The official cut off times will regulate the event. Participants must roll within this time interval not to be disqualified. The cut off times are announced in each race day sections of this document.

Feed Technical Zone

- Feed Zones match technical zones.
- Out of the enabled zones the refreshments and technical assistance are prohibited.
- Interaction between feeders and riders will only be allowed in the feed/technical assistance zones.
- The feed technical zones will be **self-service**, so each athlete will have to manage their own stops.
- There will be bins at the beginning and at the end of each feed technical zone. There won't be any along the rest of the course.
- Same protocol measures must be implemented with the team members in the technical assistance zone.
- Participants will have access to the feed technical zone which will also be in contact with the emergency staff and the organization team.
- It is forbidden for riders to return in the opposite direction of the race traffic to access the feed/technical assistance zone once it has been passed.
- There will be a separated area in the Feed Zones for Elites.
- The assistance zones are prepared (signs, tables, containers, tents, garbage bins, food, etc) and ready for use at least 45 minutes before the first rider is expected to arrive.
- Before arriving at the assistance zones, riders will see clear signage to indicate that they are approaching them from an adequate distance away with the following signs:

Any illicit aid involves the disqualification of the participant. Any aid out of the Feed Technical Zone involves disqualification. People and vehicles without accreditation won't be able to access the Feed Technical Zones. Accreditations must be required to the Organisation via email at **4stage@clublasanta.com** by the 24.01.24.

Signs

The route is properly marked with signs, especially at the most technical points, such as crossings, road intersections or streets. The remaining distance to the finish line is indicated every 10km, just as the last 5kms are indicated.

Demanding climbs and technical sections: The route includes demanding climbs and technical sections in descent. It is the responsibility of the participant to decide if he can overcome it on the bike. The organisation is not responsible for accidents related to the ability of each participant or their fitness level.

Training

The Race 1 course will be marked the day prior to the race 1 start, allowing participants to train. The training will be at the participants' own risk. The race organizer is not held responsible in case of any accident, damage of material, etc.

Changes on the course

For safety reasons, the course of each stage can be altered up to the day of the race. If necessary and under serious circumstances, the organisation reserves the right, without prior notice and to ensure the correct development and safety of the event (participants, referees, staff, etc.), to delay the time of departure, modify the schedule, and / or modify or cancel a stage.

For each stage a road book is published detailing the distance, altitude, type of road, step controls, intersections, supplies/assistance points and closing time of each of the services. The road book also indicates if the start or finish is neutralized, the distance of the neutralised

section and if the stage has a neutralized arrival. This road book is purely informative and is not necessary to perform each stage.

Non-cyclable sections

The Head of the referees, Race Director, can decide that a section of the route is impracticable and impossible to cross and to divert the original route.

If this is not possible, the last check point will be taken as the arrival time.

2.3 EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

The safety of the event is guaranteed by Club La Santa's Private Security, Civil Protection Tinajo, Civil Protection Teguise, Civil Protection San Bartolomé, Local Police of the municipalities of Tinajo, Teguise, Haria and Spanish Guardia Civil. The Club La Santa Race doctor will be present throughout the entire event. A team of physiotherapists and massage therapists is available at the Club La Santa Wellness Centre, if needed.

Regarding Anti-doping controls, the race will follow the rules of the UCI for the race, and the Spanish National Anti-doping Agency will be in charge.

HOSPITEN will be the assigned medical center for federated participants and participants who have purchased the race insurance (day license).

Medical assistance by stages

Medical assistante will be present in the following areas:

- Stage 1 & 2:

- Ambulance available at the Race Start, Feed Technical Zone 1 and at the Finish Line.
- Doctor & Nurse on the course according to needs.

Stage 3:

- Ambulance available at Calle Brezo del Mar Famara (Famara) and at the Finish Line.
- Doctor & Nurse on the course according to needs.

Stage 4:

- Ambulance available at the Race Start, Puerta Costa Teguise (E-bike Race Start), Feed Technical Zone 1&4, Feed Technical Zone 3 and at the Finish Line.
- Doctor & Nurse on the course according to needs.

3. PRE RACE

3.1. TECHNICAL MEETING

A technical meeting will be held online via SLIDO on Wednesday 24th January. The referees will review the race and report possible unforeseen changes in the development of the competition. It is mandatory to watch the technical meeting which will be available in SLIDO.

3.2. ONSITE REGISTRATION

What do you need to bring?

1. Photo Identification

2. UCI license if you own one

You will be requested to show a valid 2024 license for competitive cycling:

 Participants wishing to participate in the males & females UCI Elite category must be in possession of an annual UCI license for competitive cycling. These compete for UCI points and prize money, but they must also strictly comply with the UCI regulations.

3. Race Insurance

It is the participants' responsibility to ensure they are covered by their Federation insurance on race day (Cycling Federation). The participants must have their insurance customer service contact on the weekend. Touring cycling or other sports licenses are not accepted.

You must present A or B:

- A. Valid 2024 license for competitive cycling. Participants who are in possession of a license for competitive cycling will be requested to show it in digital format or hard copy.
- B. 1 Day License. Participants who are not in possession of a license for competitive cycling, must apply for a temporary license valid only for the competition, approved by the Royal Spanish Cycling Federation (RFEC). Participants can purchase it with their online registration. Cost: 15€ for 2 or 4 stages

Participants can also purchase it on the onsite registration.

What does the registration include?

- 1. Race organisation, traffic management & volunteers
- 2. Technical briefing online
- 3. Timing and results of each stage
- 4. Race day on-course nutrition at the feed technical zones
- 5. Free Mechanic assistance on race days only at the start and finish areas.
- 6. First aid assistance
- 7. Pick up service on the course in case of drop out.
- 8. Bike wash service (water gun)
- 9. Participant race pack
- 10. Finisher Medal for the 4 stages Finishers
- 11. Finisher certificate
- 12. Race 4: Relaxation massages provided by the students at a Massage Therapy school are available at the Finish area of Race 4, on a first-come, first-serve basis. In case you need a therapeutic massage, you will need to contact a Physiotherapist.

Race pack collection

What do I get?

- Race pack
 - ✓ Two BIBs:
 - 1 Race number for the back of the participant
 - 1 Race Plague for the handlebar of the bike
 - ✓ 4 safety pins to attach the race number to the jersey.
 - ✓ 4 zip ties to attach the race plaque to the bike.
 - ✓ Chip with Velcro
 - ✓ A sticker/label for participants' personal bag
- Extra purchases
- Welcome bag with nutrition
- Official Participant GOBIK jersey (For registrations after the 18.12.2023 we can't guarantee the right size).

4. RACE DAY

4.1 Important information

Feed Technical Zones: self-service aid stations

226ERS is the nutrition brand available during the 4 STAGE MTB Race Lanzarote 2024. The aid stations at the feed technical zones will be **self-service**, so each athlete will have to manage their own stops and **re-fill their own bike bottles**.

The organisation will not provide bike bottles at the feed technical zones.

Bike mechanic service

The organisation will provide bike tech on the feed zones during race day. Bike tech service will be also available before and after the race. Shimano Más Deportes team and E-Bike Lanzarote will provide bike tech assistance in the following times:

- **Stage 1** at Club La Santa:
 - o From 09:30 until the race start
 - o During 1 hour after the final cut off
- Stage 2 at Club La Santa:
 - From 08:00 until the race start
 - During 1 hour after the final cut off
- Stage 3:
 - o At Caleta de Famara from 08:15 until the last participant'start
- Stage 4 at Club La Santa:
 - o From 08.00 until the race start

Shimano Mas Deporte will provide mechanical assistance on the technical zones during every stage except of the 3rd one.

Information Point

The information point will be available on the start area everyday. In this tent, the participants can find all the information they need, including spare materials/equipment in case they need them. The Information tent will be open the following times:

- Stage 1 at Club La Santa: From 09:30 until one hour after the cut off at the finish area.
- Stage 2 at Club La Santa: From 08:00 until one hour after the cut off at the finish area.
- Stage 3:
 - At Caleta de Famara from 08:15
 - o At the finish area in "Ermita de Las Nieves" until 15.00hrs
- Stage 4 at Club La Santa: From 08.00 until one hour after the cut off at the finish area.

Nutrition marking

Before participants enter the starting grid, the volunteers will mark all personal nutrition items that participants carry during the race with their race number. This way, the organization can identify the owner of any litter found along the course.

The commissaires reserve the right to disqualify any participant who does not respect the environment, or the private properties encountered on the race course, and to expel him/her without possibility of continuing to participate in the competition.

Parking

Please follow the directions of the Security Guards, parking signs and Police officers for the parking area at Club La Santa.

Personal Bag drop

There will be a bag area available where participants can leave their bags. Participants will need to leave their bag in the assigned area right before entering the grid. The bags must be labelled with the label with their race number. Participants will collect their bag after the race by showing the race number to the bag area team. No bag will be handed without the race number.

Self-transport

Participants will need to reach the start area and go back to their accommodation with their own means (cycling, car rental, etc.).




